PRIZES: PRIZES ARE ALL CASH TO PLACES LISTED, PLUS NUMEROUS TOP QUALITY PRIMES.

COURSE: Start/Finish line is on Canoga Avenue, between Oxnard Street and Califa Avenue, in front of TGI Fridays. The course is a four-corner, 0.7 mile, flat, fast loop.

RULES: All USA Cycling rules apply. Helmets mandatory. Bring your trainers. Absolutely no warming up in parking lots or on race course. Free lap rule in effect. Bring your own wheels - wheels in, wheels out. Prizes awarded immediately after results are official. No prizes will be given without racer's number.

SCNCA Championship Rules: 1) You must have an annual USAC license. You cannot enter with a one-day license, a foreign license, or with a CBR license; 2) You must be a USA Citizen or a Permanent Resident. If your license has an "N" for Citizen, you will be not be able to register for the race; 3) Riders who meet the entry requirements, but live outside the SCNCA territory, can compete but are not eligible for any title, medal, or jersey. The three top spots are reserved for the first three SCNCA riders; and 4) State championships are open only to USAC, UCI Men's Continental, or UCI Women's Team members who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the state as shown on their licenses.

REGISTRATION: Online registration available at WWW.SOCALREG.COM. Bring your written pre-reg confirmation with you on race day. Online registration closes 11:59 pm on Thursday, May 27, 2010. Mail-in registration must be postmarked by May 25, 2010. After that add \$6.00. Extra races are \$7.00 each after highest race paid. All unattached riders (except for Women's 4 riders and Cat 5's) are \$5.00 extra. One day licenses for Women's 4's and Cat 5's only and annual licenses for all riders will be available on race day. Fees include \$3.00 USCF insurance. Make check payable and mail standard 2010 USCF release form to: **Warner Velo**, 21300 Victory Boulevard, Suite 820, Woodland Hills, CA 91367.

LOCATION: From the Ventura Freeway (101) North on Canoga Avenue and proceed to race course. From Simi Valley Freeway (118) South on Topanga Canyon, Left on Erwin, then right on Canoga.

PARKING: Available at the Warner Center Business Park on the east side of Canoga Avenue, between Califa and Oxnard. Some limited street parking is available adjacent to the course.
