Registration:

Individual Events: \$15 per event

Team Events: \$15 per rider

International-style Omnium: \$60

International-style Omnium riders may be eligible for individual State Championship events with payment of separate entry fees.

Mass start races for International-style Omnium and individual State Championships will be raced together; mass start fields are strictly limited to 24 total riders; registration is first come first served.

Location/Directions/Parking: The LA Event Center Velodrome is located at the Home Depot Center (HDC) in Carson, CA. See www.homedepotcenter.com for driving directions. Limited free parking is available at the HDC lots. Additional parking is available in adjacent Cal State University Dominguez Hills remote parking lots for a fee.

Velodrome Eligibility: For mass start races you must be a track Category 1 or 2 or hold a LA Event Center Velodrome Certification. NO Certification will be offered the day of the race.

Awards: SCNCA medals will be awarded to the top 3 eligible finishers/teams in all events. The winner of each event will be authorized to purchase a SCNCA State Championship Jersey from Voler as State Champion. For team events, members of the winning team will be authorized to purchase SCNCA State Championship Jersey from Voler.

2010 SCNCA Championship Eligibility per USAC rules:

1. You must have an annual USAC license. You cannot enter with a one-day license, a foreign license, or with a CBR license.
2. You must be a USA Citizen or a Permanent Resident. If your license has an "N" for Citizen, you will not be able to register for the race.
3. Riders who meet the entry requirements, but live outside the SCNCA territory (defined as Zip Codes 89000-89299 in NV and 90000-93599 in CA) can compete but are not eligible for any title, medal, or jersey. The three top spots are reserved for the first three SCNCA riders.

Other Information:

- **All teams must register by 8:30 am Sunday, August 22.**
- WWW.socalreg.com charges a fee for race entries.
- Registration is located on concourse.
- Track Usage Fees are also required by the Home Depot Center in addition to LAVRA Entry Fees. Track Usage Fees are \$20 per session or riders can purchase a 10-session card for \$160. Annual “unlimited use” cards are also available. Riders can reduce Track Usage Fees to \$10 per session by volunteering at LAVRA, USA Cycling, UCI or other track events held at the LA Event Center Velodrome. See <http://LAVelodrome.org> for volunteer opportunities. Riders shall be identified as volunteers by the Velodrome Director. Junior Track Usage Fees are \$10 unless otherwise specified by the Velodrome Director. Track Usage Fees are paid day of race.
- **Riders must wear their race numbers at all times when on the track surface, including warmup.**
- Madison riders must have previous Madison race experience and/or be approved by the Velodrome Director and race promoter.
- The promoter reserves the right to shorten any of the race distances or modify the event to fit the field.
- The points race sprints will occur every 10 laps unless otherwise posted.
- Please do not cross the track surface unless directed to do so by Velodrome Director, Officials, or race promoter. Riders may not cross the track during warm up. **Use south entry for bikes and gear.**
- Check WWW.LAVelodrome.org for current parking information and race updates.
- All mass start fields are limited to 24 riders.
