### 2009 SCNCA Championship Eligibility

Per USAC rules, here are the requirements to enter any SCNCA Championship event:

1. You must have an annual USAC license. You cannot enter with a one-day license, a foreign license, or with a CBR license.
2. You must be a USA Citizen or a Permanent Resident. If your license has an "N" for Citizen, you will not be able to register for the race.
3. Riders who meet the entry requirements, but live outside the SCNCA territory, can compete but are not eligible for any title, medal, or jersey. The three top spots are reserved for the first three SCNCA riders.

#### SCNCA Elite Track Championships

Men 1K & 4K Time Trials, Sprint, Team events - Cat 1 - 5 Racing age 17+

Men Points, Scratch & Madison - Cat 1 - 3 Racing age 17+

Women All Events Cat 1 - 4 Racing age 17+

#### Elite Nationals Qualifier

Men Time Trials Cat 1 - 4 Racing age 17+

Men Mass Start Cat 1 - 3 Racing age 17+ (Elite Nationals restricted to Cat 1-2)\*

Women All Events Cat 1 - 4 Racing age 17+ (Elite Nationals restricted to Cat 1-3 for sprint & mass start events)\*

\* If you are a Cat 3 Male or Cat 4 Female and you qualify, you will need to upgrade in order to compete at Elite nationals

### Directions to the San Diego Velodrome

Take I-5, Exit Pershing Drive

Take Pershing Drive through Florida Street intersection and continue uphill (Golf Course is on right side)

Turn on to first driveway on left

Drive through paved lot and continue on to dirt road and through dirt parking lot  
Velodrome is to the North of the dirt parking lot. Parking is only permitted in the dirt lot, you may drive up to the Velodrome to unload and then park in lot.

The following includes information on the 2009 San Diego Velodrome Championships. These Championships will qualify riders directly to the 2009 USA Cycling Elite National Track Championships to be held in Carson, CA at the ADT Event Center on September 30 - October 4.

The 2009 USAC Velodrome Championships are open to Male cyclists who hold a valid USA Cycling racing license, have a racing age of 17 or above and are track category 4 and above for time trial events and track category 3 or above for mass start events. Female cyclists who hold a valid USA Cycling racing license and have a racing age of 17 or above can ride in all events. This means that there may be riders competing in the Velodrome Championships who may NOT be qualified to ride the USA Cycling Elite National Track Championships. Elite Nationals restricted to Cat 1-2 Men and Cat 1-3 Women for the Sprints, Scratch, Points and Madison events.

Cyclists who place high enough to qualify for the USA Cycling Elite National Track Cycling Championships will do so in one of two areas: Sprint or Endurance. If you wish to ride both Sprint and Endurance events at Elite nationals, you MUST qualify in both areas.

Who Qualifies for Elite nationals?

**Men:**

The top 5 riders in Individual events and the top 3 in the team events qualify.

**Women:**

The top 3 riders in individual events and the 1st team in team events qualify.

Prior to entry, cyclists should check that they meet all other requirements for entry into championship events (proof of citizenship, category restrictions, etc.). If a cyclist who is not eligible finishes in a qualifying position, that position will be assumed by the next eligible cyclist.
