**DIRECTIONS:** El Dorado Park is located on the eastern edge of Long Beach, along the 605 Freeway. From the south: travel north on 405 fwy. to the 605 fwy, go north on the 605. Exit 605 at Willow St./Katella Ave. Follow signs to Willow exit (west). Proceed west on Willow to Studebaker St., turn right on Studebaker. Proceed north to Spring St., turn right on Spring. Travel approximately .5 miles east on Spring to the El Dorado Park entrance, turn left into the park. Follow signs to Area III. From the north: travel to 605 fwy., proceed south on 605. Exit 605 fwy. at Spring St. Proceed west on Spring for .1 miles to park entrance. Turn right into park, follow signs to Area III. From east or west: travel to 91 fwy. Proceed east or west to 605 fwy. Proceed south on 605. Exit 605 fwy. at Spring St. Proceed west on Spring for .1 miles to park entrance. Turn right into park, follow signs to Area III. Please be advised there will be a \$7 parking fee charged by the park.

**THE COURSE:** The course is a mixture of mostly grass, pavement, dirt and sand. The terrain is slightly rolling with a small hill run-up, artificial and natural barriers requiring dismounting. Each lap is approximately 3km in length. Races are timed circuits on the course based on category.

**THE VENUE:** World famous El Dorado Park Area III has been the home of the El Dorado Park Racing Series for over twenty years. The area is lush with large areas of grass, lots of trees for ample shade, slightly rolling terrain and a tranquil lake. It is family-friendly with a kids playground, with lots of scenic area to explore and plenty of great spots to picnic and watch the racing. Bring the kids, bring the parents--there's something everyone will enjoy!

**REGISTRATION:** Save \$\$\$, save time and pre-register on-line at [Sportsbase Online](http://Sportsbase Online).

Series discount passes available at Sportsbase Online. Go to: [www.SoCalCross.org](http://www.SoCalCross.org) and click on the registration link. Each time you pre-register, you will be automatically entered to win a Fuji CX frame and Fork! Online registration closes Thursday, October 15th at 9:00PM (Pacific). Race Day registration is available opens at 8:00am and closes 20 minutes prior to each race category start.

**ENTRY FEES:** Pre-Registration entry fee is \$25.00 (add \$5 for race day entry) for all CX categories except, Juniors (10-18 yrs) race Junior race for FREE with USA Cycling license, or purchase one-day license for \$10. Juniors must pay regular entry fee for category races if NOT entering Junior race. Additional race entries are just \$5.00/per race after higher entry fee is paid.

A valid USA Cycling license is required for all race participants. Annual USAC licenses can be purchased online at: [www.USACycling.org](http://www.USACycling.org) or at registration on race day. Cost for USAC annual license is \$60 (\$30 for Juniors) and expire on 12/31/2009. A 2010 license can be purchased starting 12/1/2009. A One-Day license is available with pre-registration or on race day for \$10. One Day licensed riders are eligible to race CX4 level events including Masters categories: Women 35+, Men 35+ 3/4, Men 45+ and 55+. One Day licensed riders are not eligible for District Championships.

**RULES:** Event held under USA Cycling Permit. All 2009 USA Cycling and CX rules apply. Event will be held rain or shine, no refunds. Cyclocross and Mountain Bikes (no bar ends) are welcomed. Bike and wheel changes are allowed in the designated pit areas. Riders must wear helmets when on the bike at all times. Riders shall stay on the course or existing trails. Please respect the venue and local residents. No feeds are allowed on course except under discretion of the race officials. Sleeveless jersey/shirts are not allowed. Warming up on the Course – Once the last rider has crossed the line in the current active wave, the officials will allow riders to “pre-ride” the course so they can become familiar with route. Once the next race has started, they need to withdraw from the course before the first rider passes them. There should be enough time for them to complete one lap. As in the past, these riders cannot cross the finish line.

As a general rule, Road and MTB riders who race cyclocross should be racing in categories as listed below.

Please upgrade when eligible.

Cyclocross Cat 1: Road Pro or Cat 1; MTB Pro      Cyclocross Cat 2: Road 2; MTB 1 or 2  
Cyclocross Cat 3: Road 3; MTB 1 or 2      Cyclocross Cat 4: Road 4 or 5; MTB 3; One-day license

**CYCLOCROSS RACING AGE:** A rider's racing age for the 2009-10 Cyclocross Season is the 'racing age' they'll be the year of the CX World Championships which take place in January 30-31, 2010. Your racing age for the entire cyclocross season running September 2009 through January 2010 is based on your age as of 12/31/2010.

**RESULTS:** Race results will be posted near the awards area immediately following each race. Please make sure to check your results within the 15 minute posting/protest period or they will be final.
